### **FLORIDA ASSOCIATION OF MORTGAGE BROKERS BROWARD CHAPTER TO HOST CONGRESSMAN KLEIN AT SEMINAR**

**Fort Lauderdale, FL – September 24, 2008** – The Broward Chapter of the Florida Association of Mortgage Brokers (FAMB) will host four-hours of continuing education courses for all mortgage professionals on Wednesday, October 15 from 1:30-5:30 p.m. at Dave and Buster's, located at 3000 Oakwood Boulevard in Hollywood.

FAMB and the Office of Financial Regulations will present a course on *Chapter FS 494* to keep all mortgage professionals informed and in compliance with the State of Florida for license renewal. OFR will examine issues, changes to and present an overview of *Chapter FS 494*. Participants will learn how to properly disclose to consumers based on the changes to FS 494 enacted on October 1, 2007. OFR will prepare participants for what to expect when they receive the examination notice and how to correctly comply.

Following *Chapter FS 494, Reverse Mortgages-Key Concepts* will be presented by an industry expert. This is a non-continuing education course, but the presentation will give attendees an insight into originating reverse mortgages. Cost to attend both education courses is \$12.00 for professional and additional professional affiliates, \$10.00 for supporter members, \$20.00 for non-FAMB members and \$5.00 for FAMB Education Foundation subscribers.

Following the education courses, Congressman Ron Klein (FL-22) will update attendees on current legislative issues. He will also answer questions about the local economy and the housing industry. Cost to attend for FAMB members is \$27.00, \$57.00 for non-members and free to participants of the continuing education courses. Dinner will be served.
